- Completed Application to Replace Alien Registration Card Form I-90
- Police report
- Statement (affidavit) from the applicant explaining what happened to their green card
- Photo copies of valid Guyanese passport pages (whenever possible showing genuine entry and exit stamps from the U.S. and Guyana)
- If applicant traveled to Guyana on an Emergency travel document then they would need a letter from the Guyana Passport Office confirming their dates of travel to Guyana.
- Identification from the U.S. such as a driver’s license, social security card
- Three recent and identical passport sized photographs 2 inches x 2 inches (full view)
- Fees: Processing fee of US\$165 or Guyanese equivalent

**Additional Documents that should be submitted with this form:**

- National identification card
- Original and/or photocopy of your resident card or proof of residency within the U.S.

Once we receive the required documents, we’ll begin processing your request for a transportation letter.
