Events Mark the End of the HSV Swift Visit

On Sept. 8 at 10 a.m. at the Amerindian Hostel, the Minister of Amerindian Affairs, Pauline Sukhai will join US Embassy Charge d'Affaires Tom Pierce in a ceremony to mark the Seabees construction at the Amerindian Hostel and the donation of approximately 50,000 high nutrition meals to the ministry.

On September 9 at 11 a.m. at Plaisance Community High School, the Minister of Education, the US Embassy Charge d'Affaires and the head mistress for the high school will join together in a ceremony to hand over a new school room and the donation of three pallets of school and first aid supplies to the Ministry of Education.

In addition to the humanitarian efforts, the service members participated in professional exchanges. The visit of U.S. Navy and Marine Corps personnel helps build relationships among security personnel. Security personnel from both governments work together to combat the drug trade and other transnational crime that threaten regional security. The visit of the HSV Swift contributes to our mutual goals of security and prosperity.
